## Expressive Arts and Design


We will continue to develop our designing and planning skills. We will be reviewing our work, suggesting what we would change next time.

We will be exploring how we find out and make decisions about combining materials together.


Also, we will be experimenting with a variety of colours and textures to create our desired affect.


