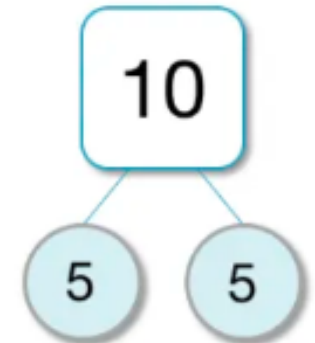
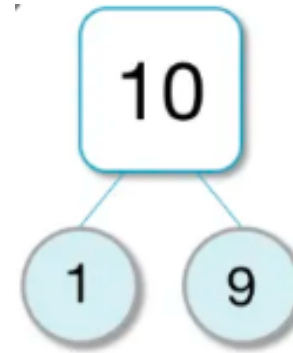
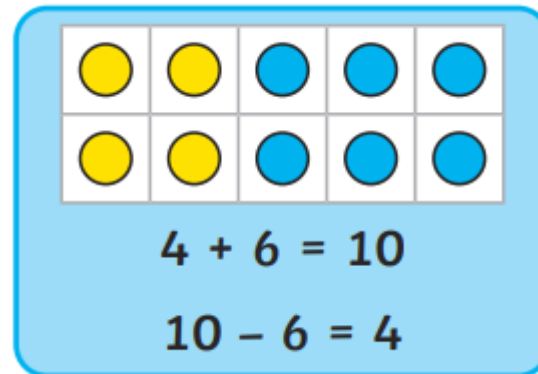


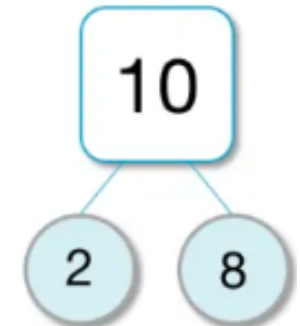
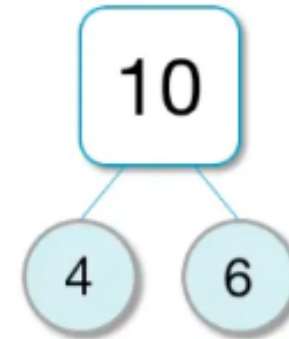
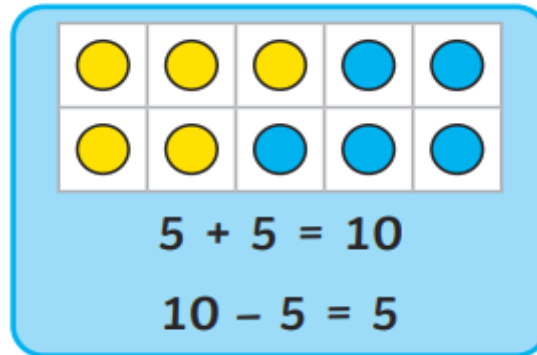


KIRF Target 1: I know my number bonds to 10.
