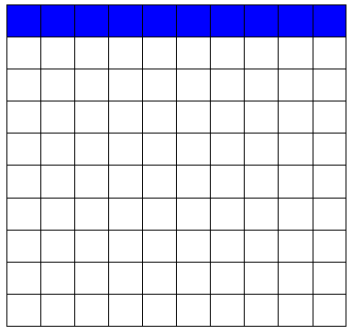
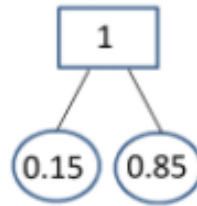




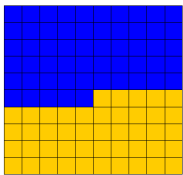
KIRF Target 27 - I can find decimal number bonds to 1.



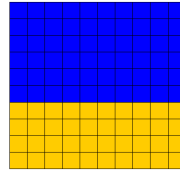
The whole square represents 1. Each tiny square represents 1/100 or 0.01.

 $0.1 + 0.9 = 1$



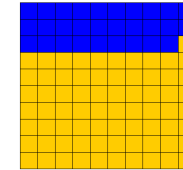
Rainbow to 1



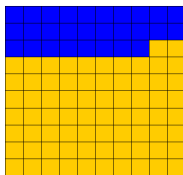
$0.55 + 0.45 = 1$



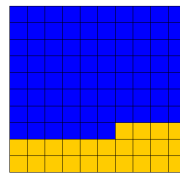

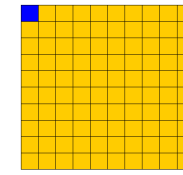
