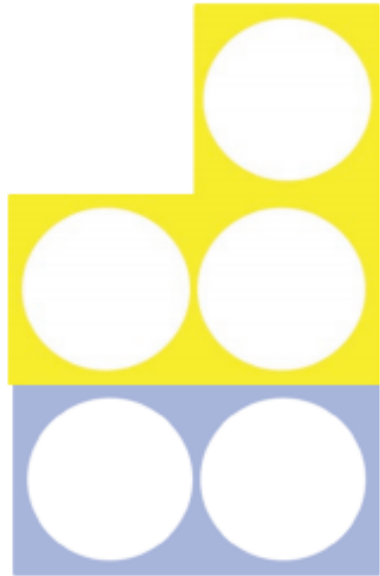
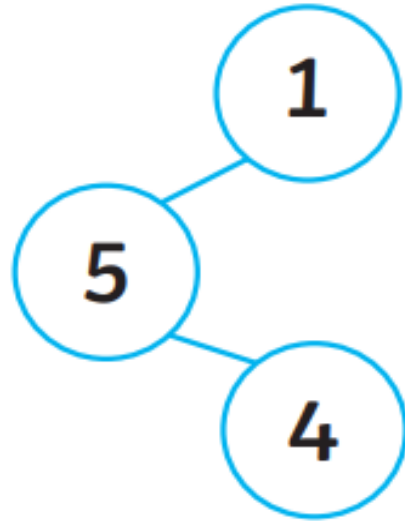




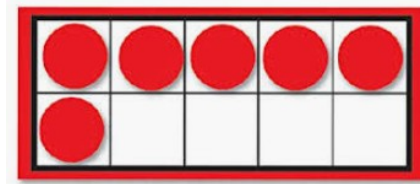
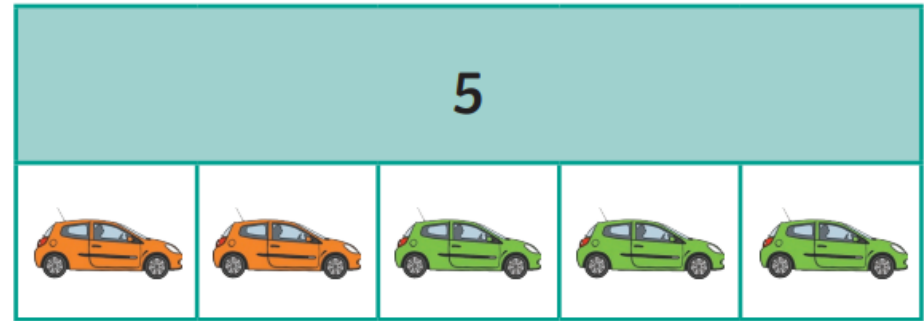
KIRF Target 2: I know number bonds for each number to 10

$5 - 3 = 2$  $2 + 3 = 5$

How can my parents help at home?

When learning key recall facts it is important to do so little but often. Now that your child is confident finding their number bonds to 10, they should focus on learning number bonds for all numbers within 10.
