Writing

Can you write a set of instructions (and even make it into a poster) about how to perform an earthquake drill correctly?



Non-Fiction Writing

Can you write your own newspaper article about a natural disaster that has happened somewhere in the world?



Music

Music is often used to create atmosphere in films and tv shows. What genres of music do you think would be appropriate in a film about different natural disasters?

STEM

Can you build an earthquake-proof structure? Try making a model 2 storey house that will withstand an 'earthquake'. You can test it out by moving the furniture underneath it.

ROOTS

Take a photo or draw a picture of yourself following out ROOTS. This could be a photo of you helping someone around the house, taking care of a sibling or being respectful.

We will be learning about earthquakes, tornadoes and hurricanes. Can you use these destructive natural disasters to inspire a piece of art work?

We will be looking at tectonic plates. Can you use household products to create models of different types of plate tectonics?
