Great Linford Police Station.

Statement taken by: Officer Faye

Date: Monday 17th April 2023 15:00

Witness: Mr Malcom Wise.

Mr Wise was stood in his garden at his residence, 12 St Leger Drive, at approximately 10.30 AM. For approximately forty-five minutes, Mr Wise reported that he was completing garden maintenance; this account has been corroborated by Mrs Wise.

At approximately 11.15AM, the suspect in question, Mr Albert Watson, was seen leaving Great Linford Primary School, travelling South towards Costa Coffee. Mr Wise states that a black satchel was being carried by the suspect at this point.

Shortly after, the witness states that he saw three members of staff exit the school building and travel in the same direction. Mr Wise reports that he heard one member of staff making a phone call to the police regarding the theft of 10 school Chromebooks.

At this point, Mr Wise spoke to the member of staff, Mr Jenkins, and proceeded to tell him that the suspect had turned East onto Wood Lane. Mr Jenkins advanced in this direction.

It is reported by Mr Wise that the suspect was a white male with short blonde hair, approximately 5ft7, wearing a dark, grey-coloured hoodie, light blue jeans and white trainers with a red stripe.

Date: Wednesday 19th April 2023 - 11:50 AM

Witness: Penelope Pink (formally Alice Jones)

Ms Pink arrived at Black Manor at 19:00. At this point, she reported that she was the only one at the residence apart from Mrs White (Doctor Black's cook/cleaner).

In between 19:00 and 19:40, the following guests arrived: Miss Scarlett, Professor Plumb, Colonel Mustard, Reverend Green and Miss Peacock. It is reported by Ms Pink that during this time Colonel Mustard and Professor Plumb were acting suspiciously; speaking secretively and whispering.

At approximately 19:40, Ms Pink left the party at Black Manor -the residence of the victim- which was taking place in the ball room. She travelled down the East Wing corridor towards the ladies restroom. During this journey, she overheard a conversation between two other suspects Mrs White and Miss Scarlett. Ms Pink has reported that Miss Scarlett was consoling Mrs White: she was upset that the victim's dog had gone missing.

As Ms Pink travelled down the corridor, she approached the billiards room. Professor Plum and Colonel Mustard were seen by Ms Pink talking in a suspicious manner. Ms Pink couldn't be sure what she had heard: the door wasn't completely open.
