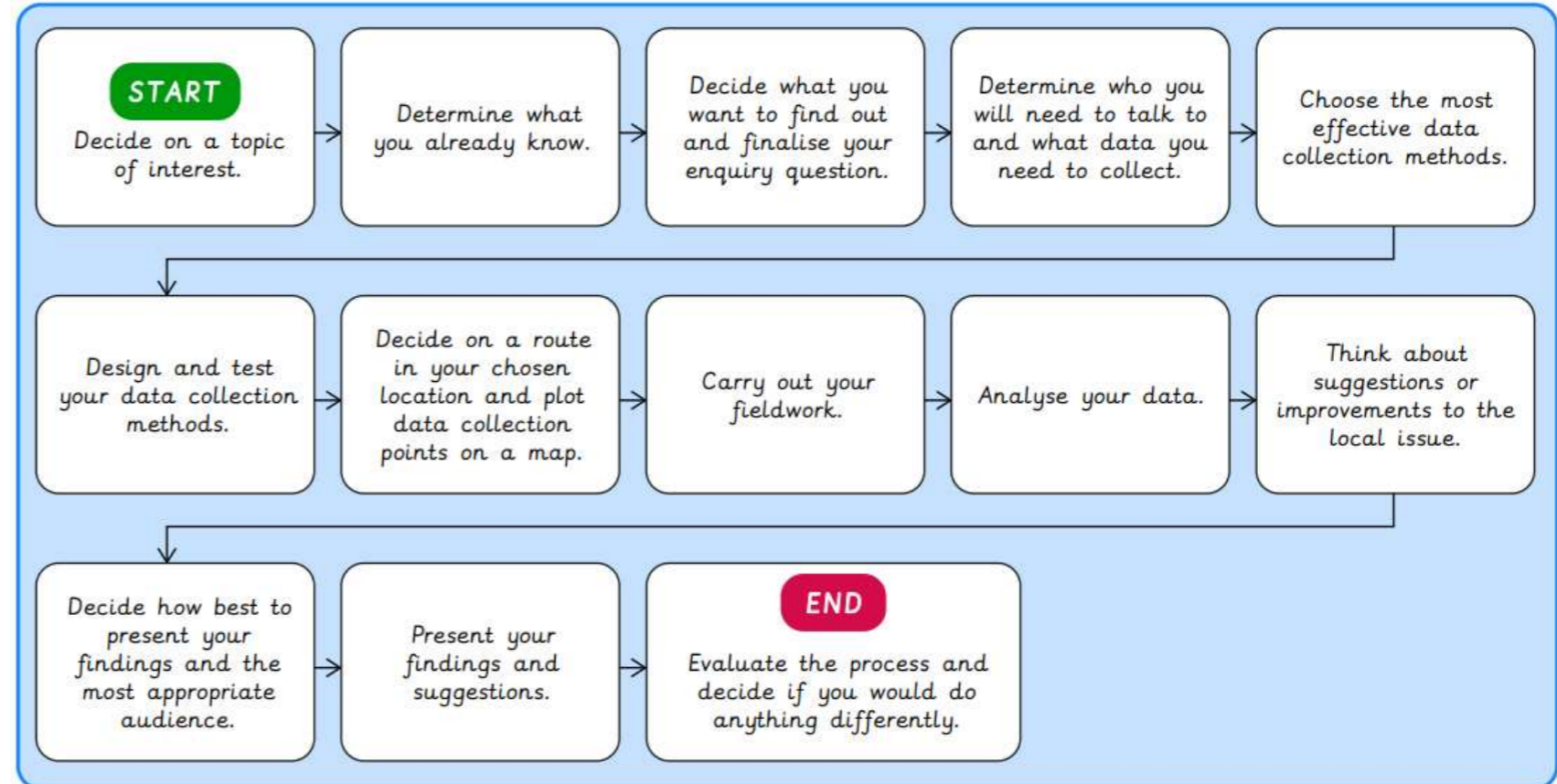


Key Vocabulary

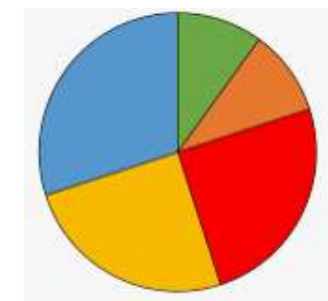
tally charts
