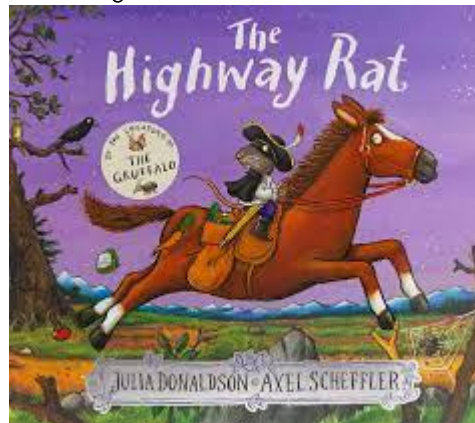


Highway rat
