Arts

- Europe has many different artists that take inspiration from the natural world and cultures around them. You could make 3d Russian dolls; a Tin Tin inspired Hergé (Belgian artist) comic strip or even just create some art inspired by the mountains of Italy or the Islands of Greece.



STEM

(Science Technology Engineering Mathematics)

- Europe has many fascinating structures built in every country. Why not design your own Eiffel Tower out of spaghetti; construct an aqueduct from clay or even design a sundial that would have graced the Palaces of Spain and France.
