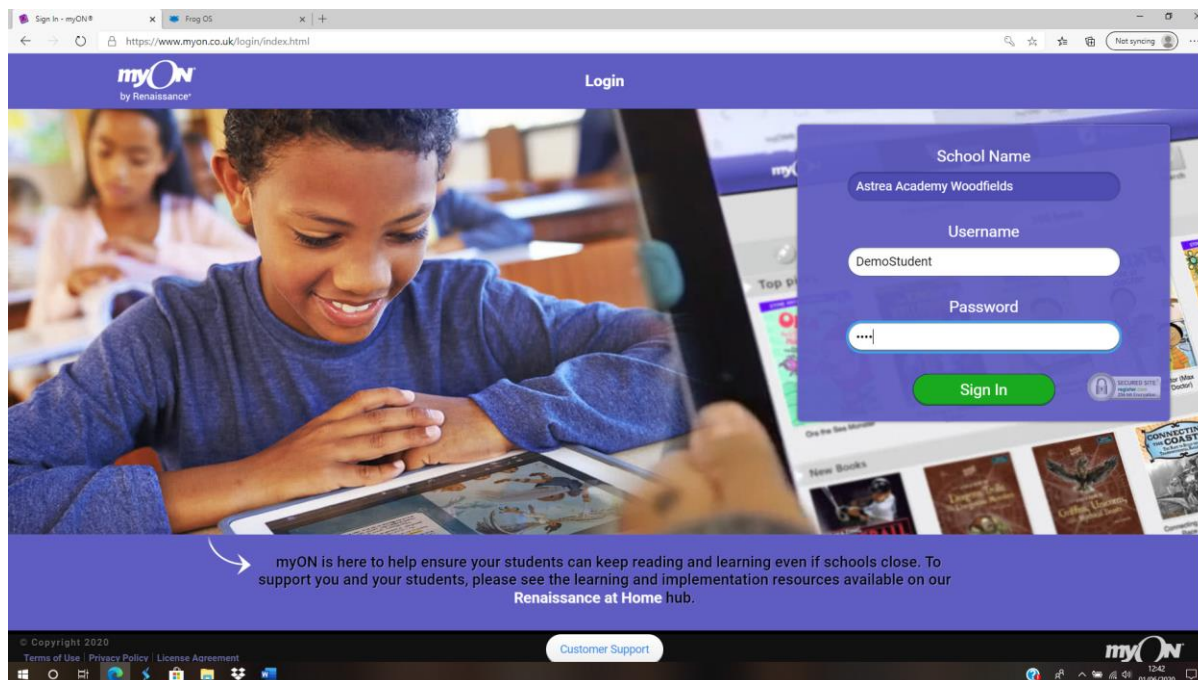


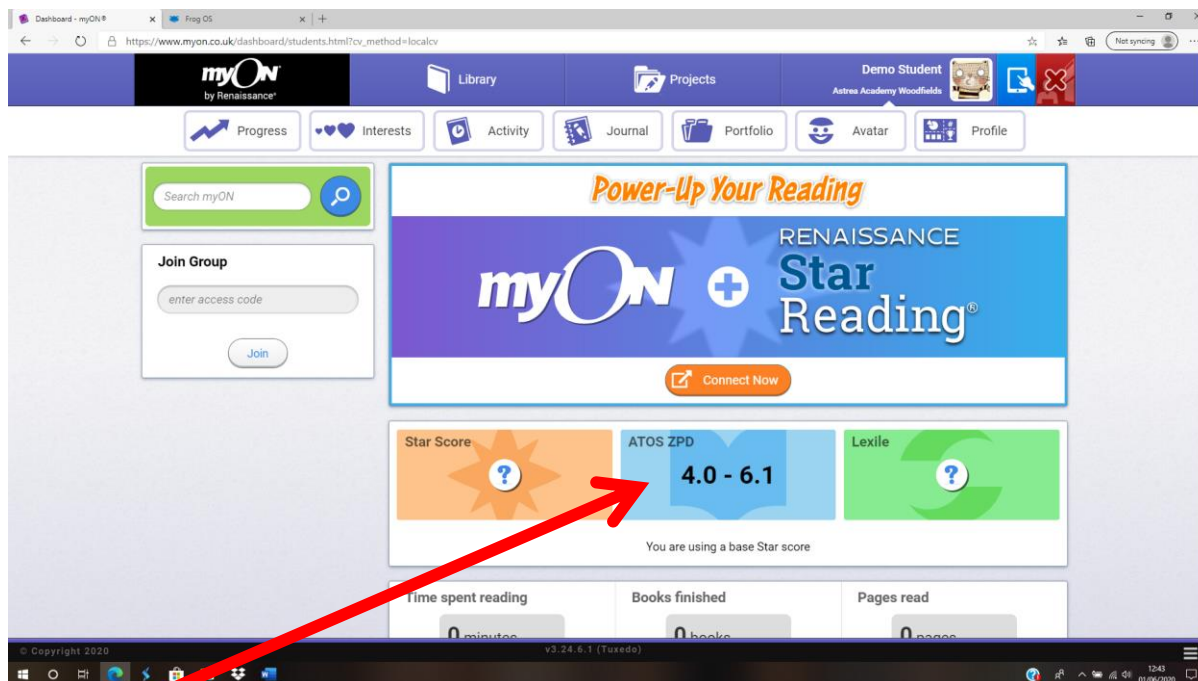
myON student access guide

On the right-hand side of the screen you will be able to see options for logging in. Begin typing Astrea Academy Woodfields into the 'School Name' box, and select from the drop-down list, as shown below. Log in using your username and password.



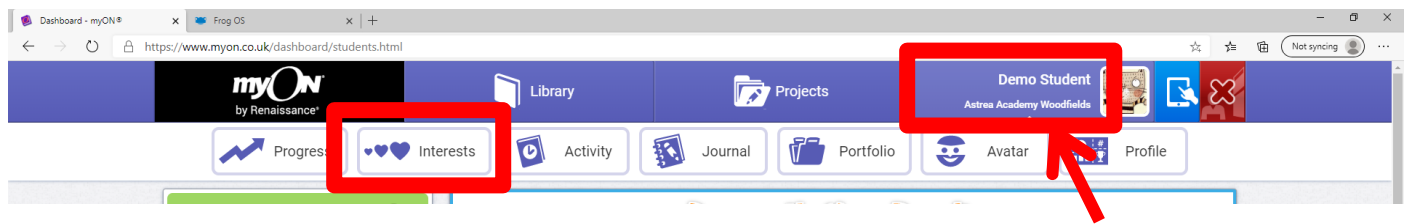
Once you have logged in, you will see this page:



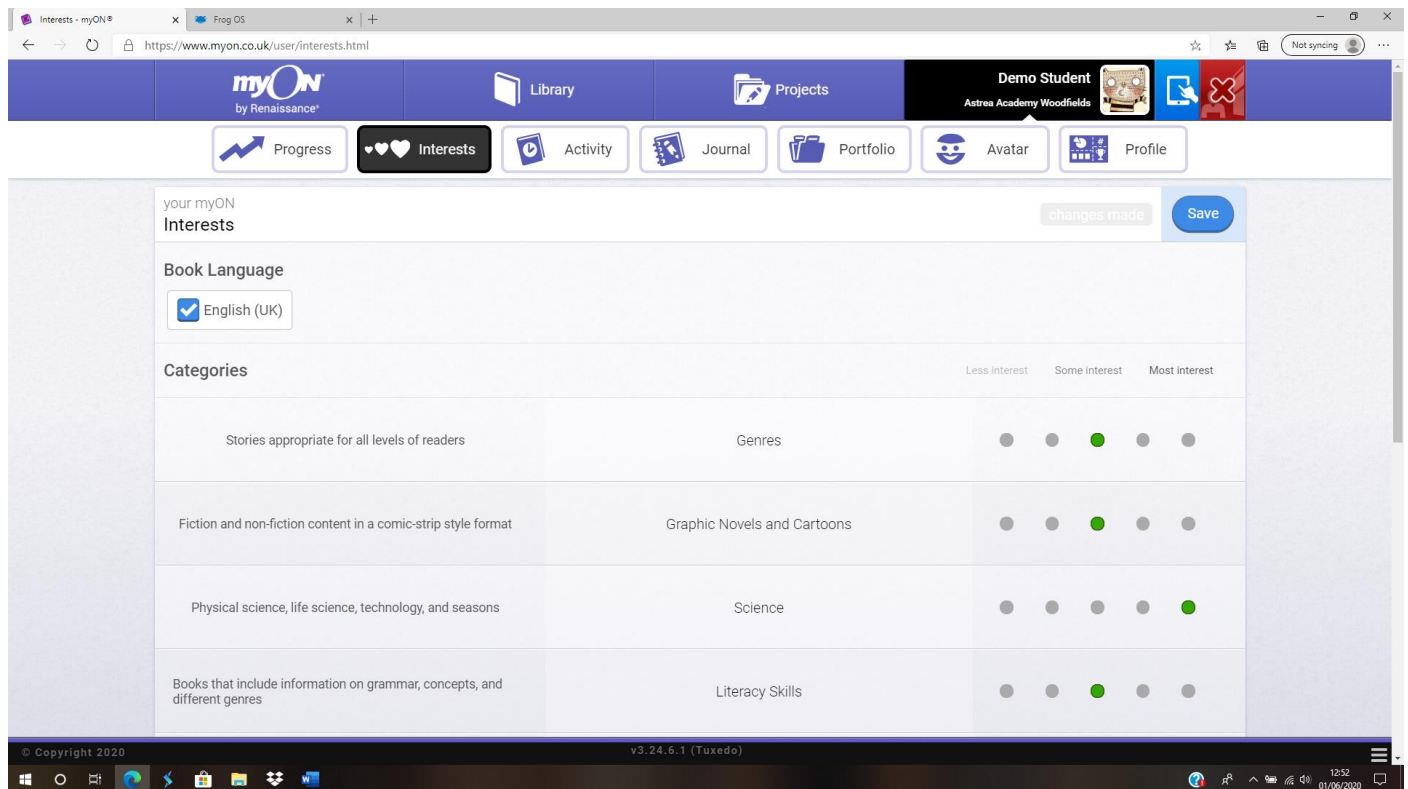
Your ZPD (zone of proximal development) score shown in the centre of the screen will remain generic (age specific) until you begin reading and completing books, it will then give you a score showing your current reading level.

Your ZPD score is not assessed, it is only there to help you find more books that you may enjoy reading, that are at the right level for you.

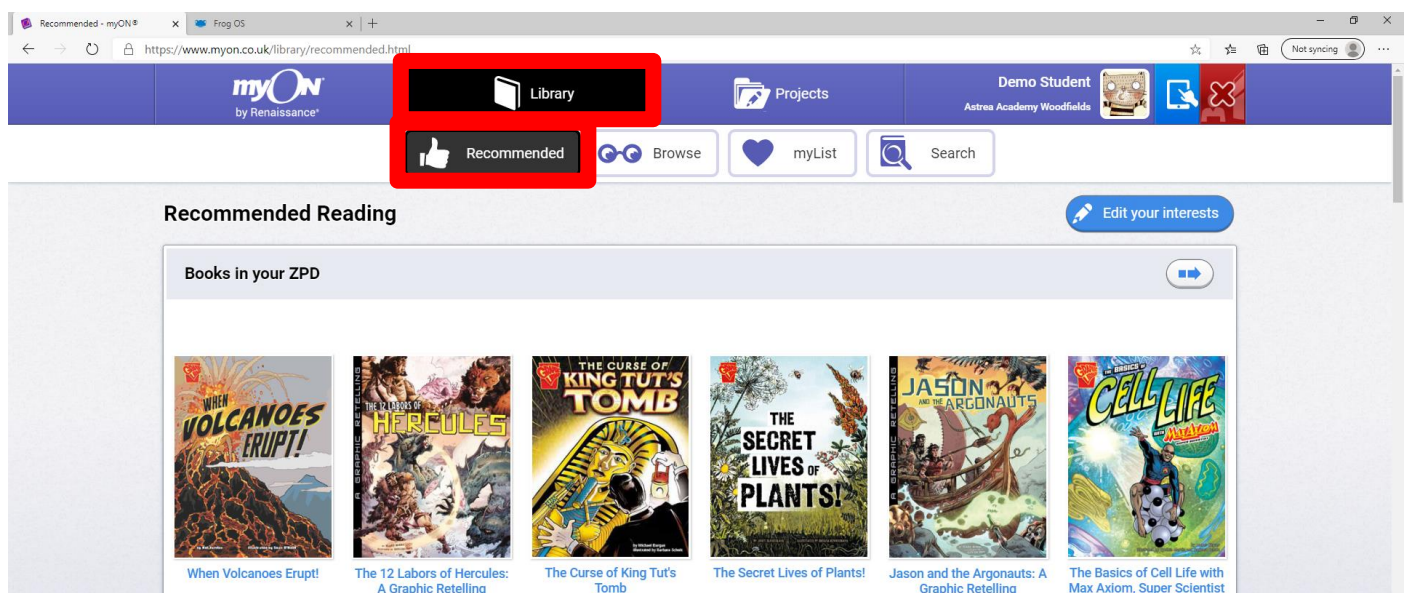
Before reading you should set up your personal interests. If you click on your name in the top right-hand corner you will be shown a row of additional tabs. Click on the 'interests' button.



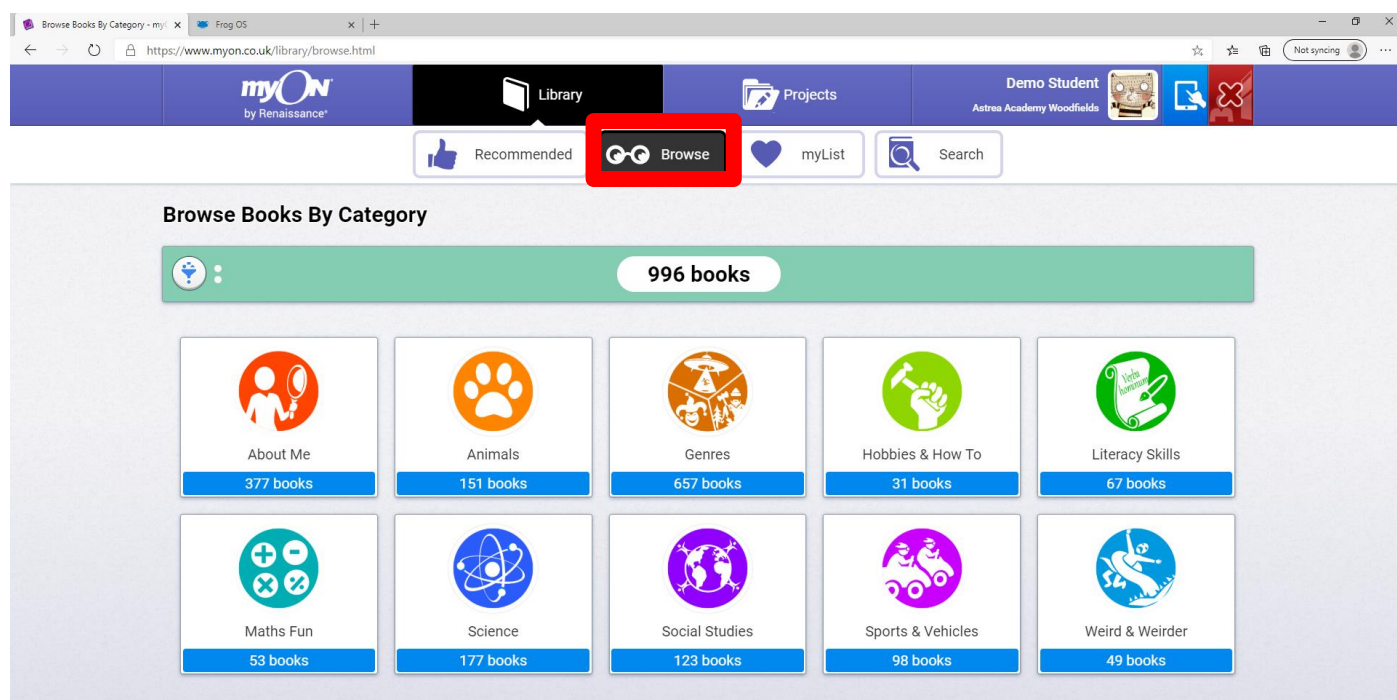
This will take you to the following page. On this page you can indicate what genres, styles, and topics you enjoy reading about.



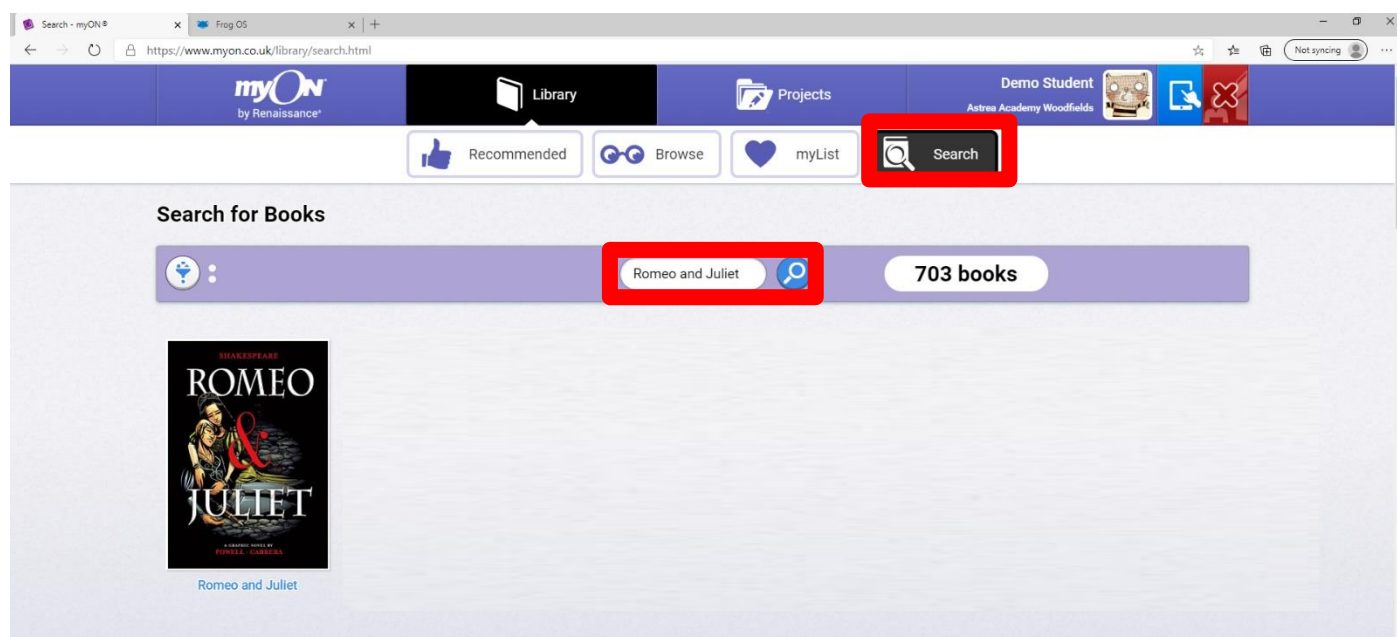
Following this, click 'Library' at the top of the page, followed by 'Recommended' and this will give you a list of books available based on the interests quiz you have completed.



If you decide you would like to read books outside of your recommended list, then click 'browse'. This will allow you to search different genres and topics that you can navigate to find a book you will enjoy reading.



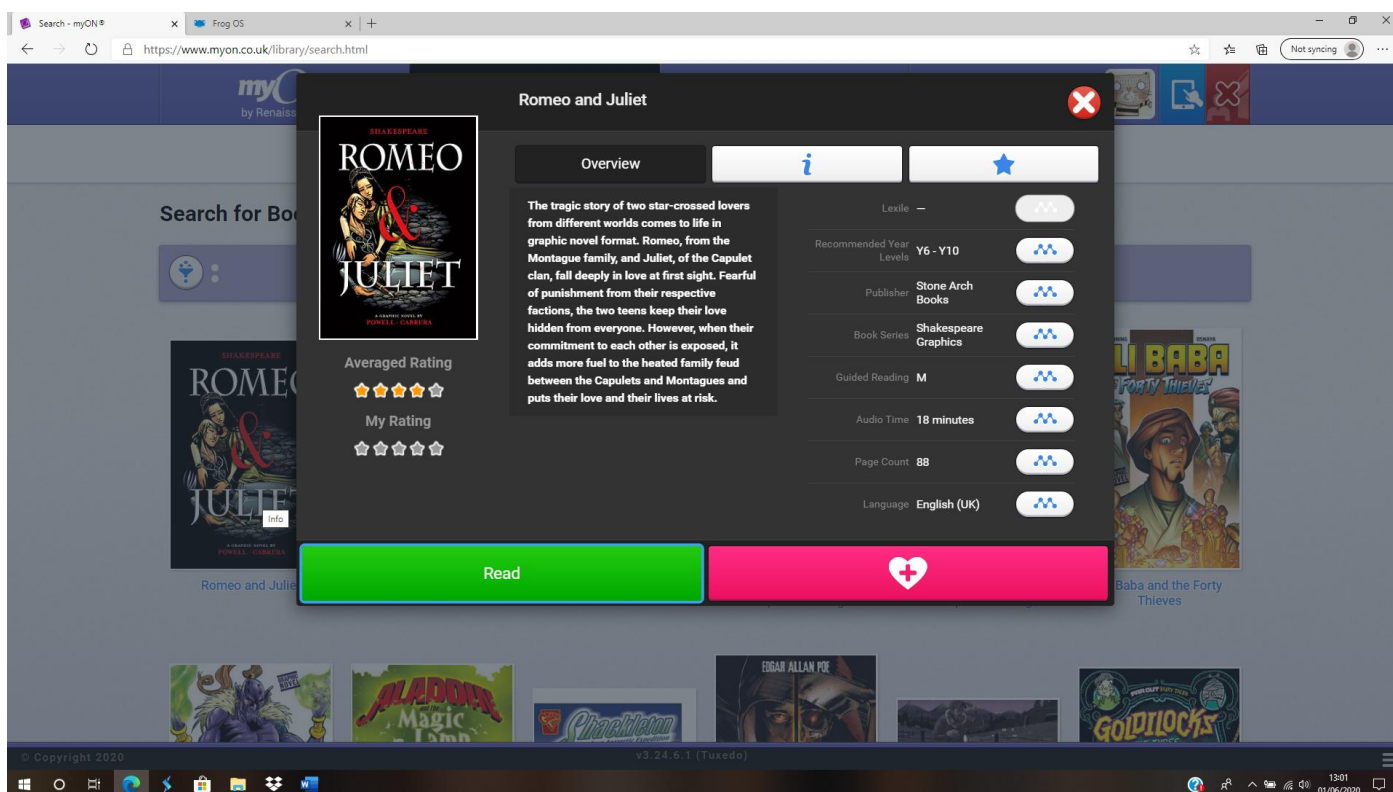
If you are looking to see if there is a specific book on this site for you to read, you can use the 'search' tool.



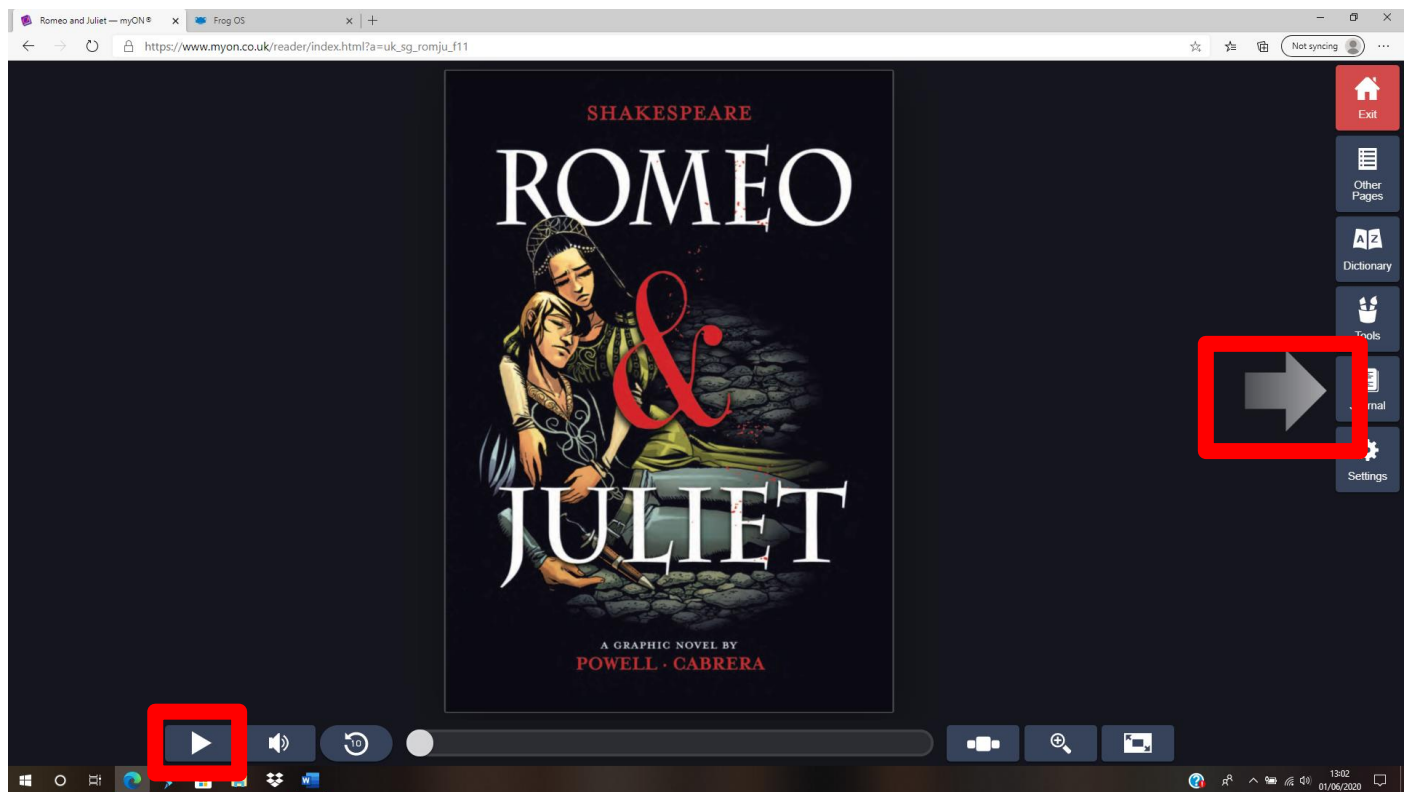
When you have chosen the book you would like to read, click on the book title. You will be shown a list of options.



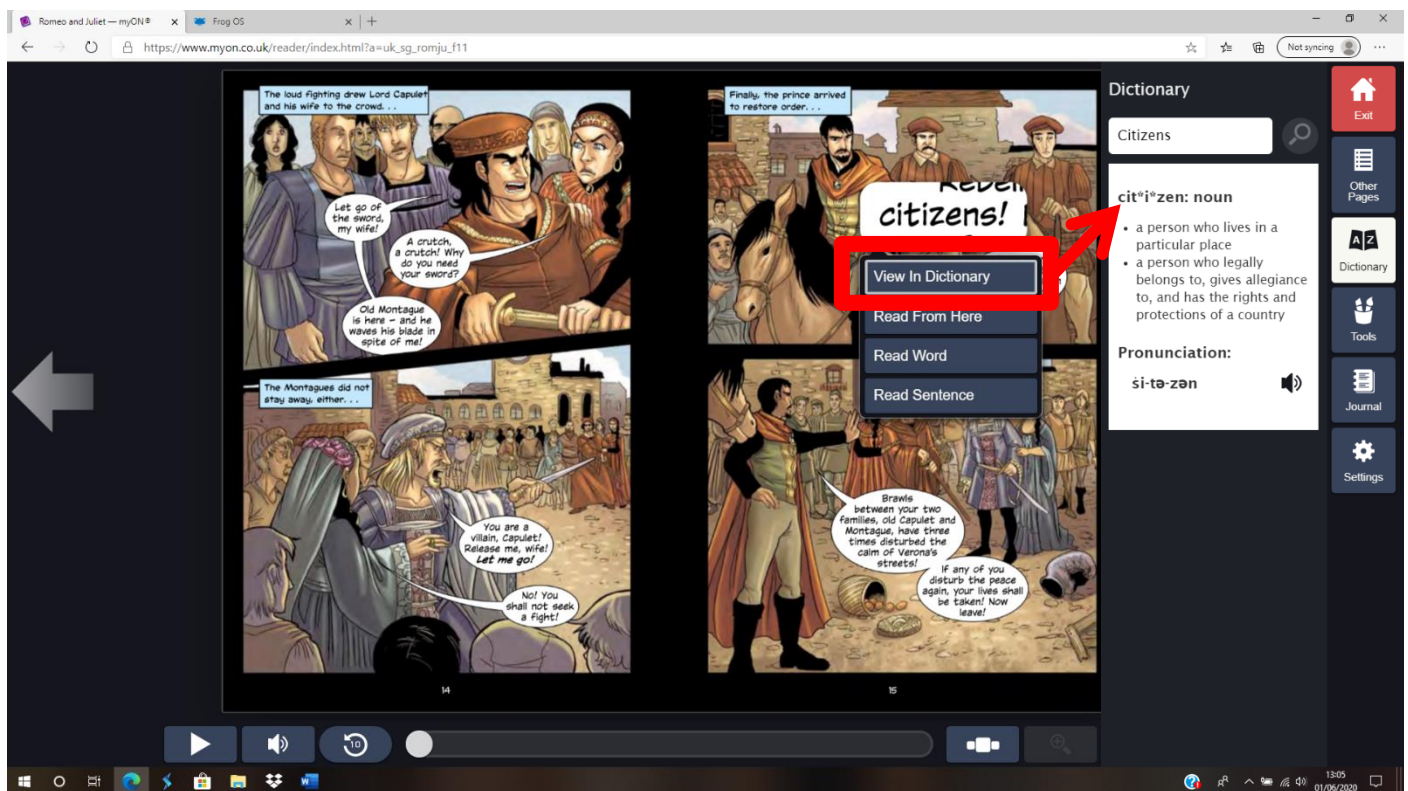
Clicking on the 'info' button will give you a short synopsis of the book, followed by how many pages it has, it's reading time, and other useful information.



When you click 'read' you will be taken to the following screen. Pressing play will have the book read aloud to you by a narrator. Click on the arrows will allow you to virtually turn the pages and read the book yourself.



Whilst reading, if you come across any words that you are unsure of, double click on the word. You will then be given the option to 'view in dictionary'. Clicking this option will give you the meaning of the word.



Once you have completed readings your homepage will adjust to show your weekly progress.
