Write a creepy tale or ghost story set on or next to a canal.	Build a bridge out of paper, card or spaghetti that could be used to travel over a canal. You could also test it out to see how much weight it could hold.	Take a photo or draw a picture of yourself following our ROOTS. This could be a photo of you helping someone around the house, taking care of a sibling or being respectful.
Music Use Chrome Music Lab to create a piece of music inspired by canals.	Poetry Write a poem about canals, boats or water. You can set your poem now or at a time in the past when canals were used to transport goods and people between cities.	Art/DT Design a floral pattern, similar to the one below, that can often be found on the side of narrow boats.
