Find out about traditional seaside Music Halls and learn to sing a favourite from this time: Oh I Do Like To Be Beside the Seaside



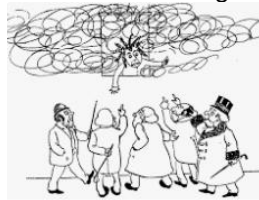
### **STEM**
