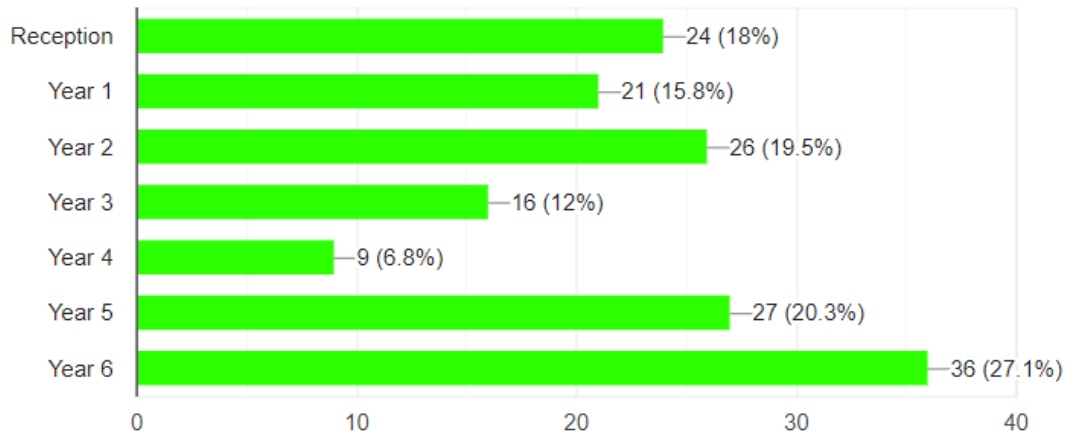




Parental View (October Parents Evening)

133 parents completed the form covering a combined total of 159 pupils when taking siblings into account.



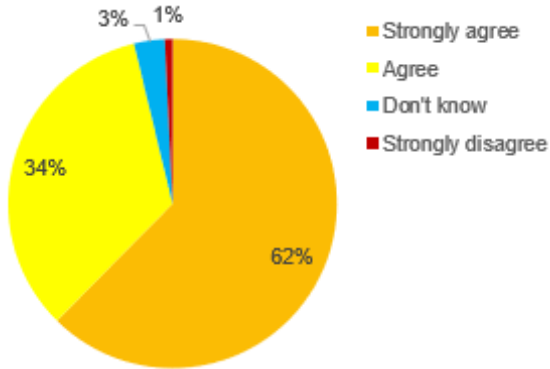
**3 of the 4 parents evenings run for Year 4 were delayed due to absence so were completed without Digital Leader support.*

Headlines

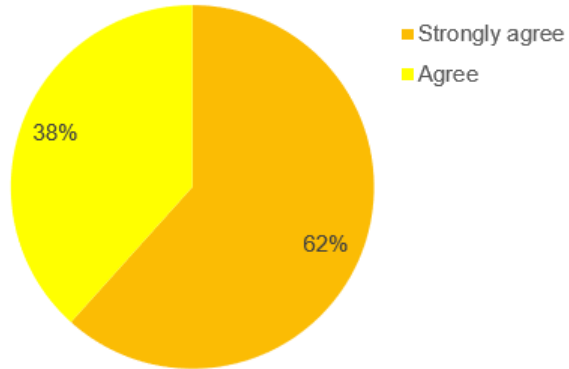
- ✓ No parent said their child did not feel safe in school.

- ✓ Only 1% of parents said the school did not set high expectations for their child.
- ✓ Only 1% of parents said their child could not take part in clubs or activities.



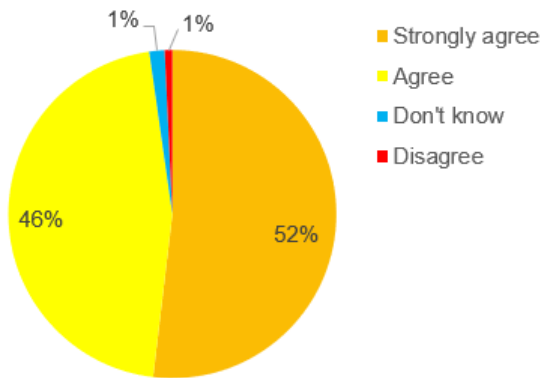

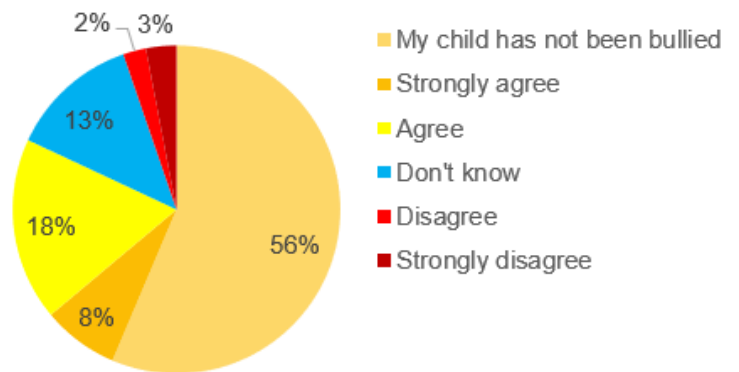
My child feels safe at this school



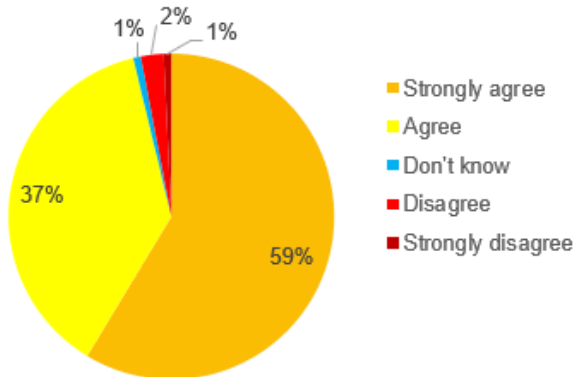
The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved



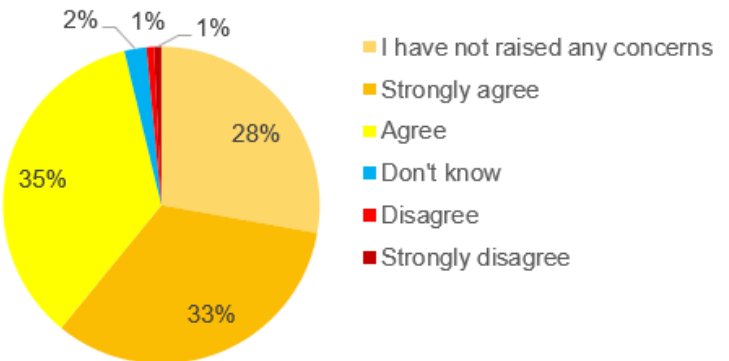
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively



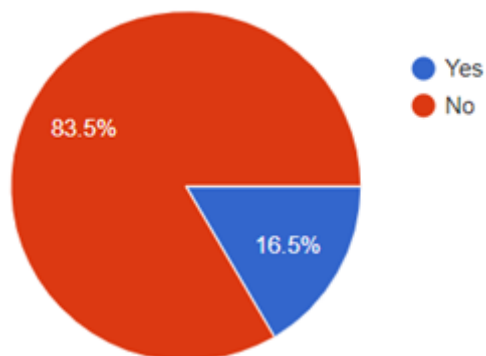
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year



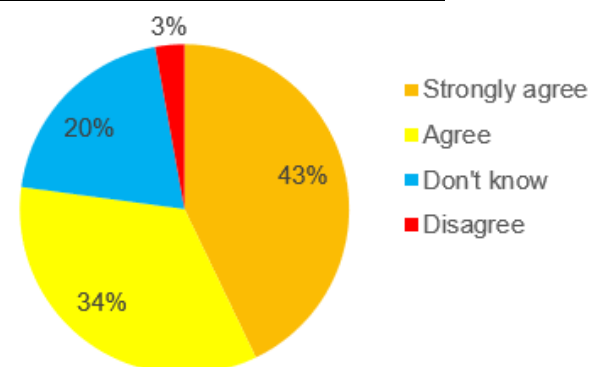

Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?

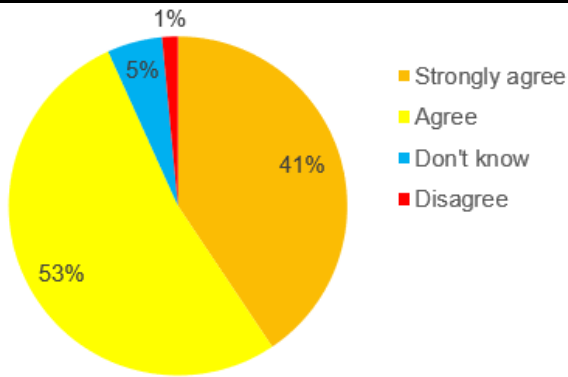

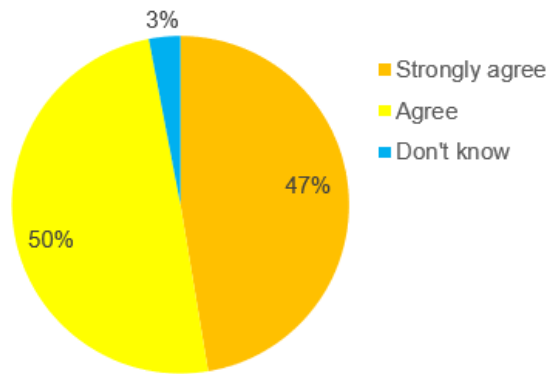

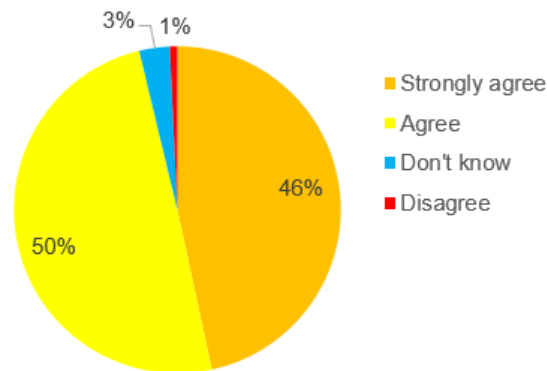

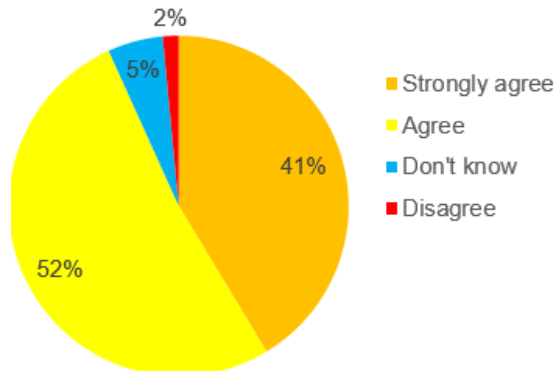

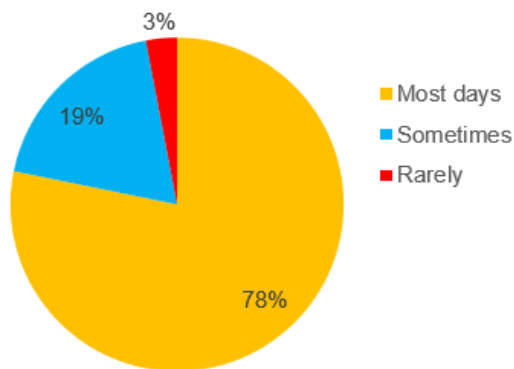
