Our team

The School Nursing Team includes:

- **School nurses**
- **Community nurses**
- **Support workers**

We work in partnership with parents, carers and children, and other professionals including:

- Health visitors
- GPs
- Community dentists
- Dieticians
- Physiotherapists

- Hospitals
- Clinic doctors
- Teachers
- Social workers
- Child and adolescent mental health services (CAMHS)

The school nurse can make referrals to services and coordinate the sharing of necessary health information between these services. Student nurses will occasionally work alongside the school nurse. If you do not wish for a student nurse to be present at an appointment, please let the school nurse know.

What do we do?

We offer a range of services that promote the good health and wellbeing of school-aged children and young people.

The School Nursing Team may provide the following services to all year groups throughout primary and secondary school:

- Health advice and support to parents / carers and school staff for children with medical conditions such as diabetes, asthma, epilepsy and severe allergies
- Health assessment and individual health and wellbeing advice
- Health awareness and healthy lifestyles teaching sessions
- Weight management advice
- Enuresis service – providing advice and support for children and young people with issues around bedwetting
- Confidential advice and support to young people

Recognising the school nurse

All team members and students carry an identity badge with their photograph on it.

We provide some specific services for certain year groups.

Reception class

- School entry health review, which includes a hearing and eye test, and height and weight measurement
- We work with the child and parent/carer to develop a healthcare plan in response to identified health concerns
- Advice on health issues and outstanding childhood vaccinations
- We support school staff to educate children on issues such as healthy eating, dental hygiene and hand washing.

Year 6

- Height and weight measurement which is part of the National Child Measurement Programme
- Hygiene and body changes sessions in school

Immunisations

Children are offered immunisations in line with the current National Immunisation programme. A signed consent form is required at the time of each immunisation.

Children with special needs

Some children may need some additional support from other services.

The school nurse may be one of the professionals who acts as the key health professional for your child in co-ordinating health information from other professionals. The school nurse attends and contributes to school assessments that involve health, education and social care.
