Choose one or many of the suggestions below. In class, we will share all our entries. All winning entries will be shared in our Home Learning Celebration.

Arts

- Mayans often carved patterns into stone using geometric patterns and faces. Create your own version through your choice of medium.
- Research the limited colours the Mayan people used and create a painting using these colours.
- Use the image as a stimulus to produce a piece of descriptive writing or use Google Slides to display research around it.



STEM

(Science Technology Engineering Mathematics)

- Design your own 3D Mayan mask.
- Research structures the Ancient Mayan people built. Can you create a map to show their locations?
- Create your own 3D Mayan temple structure including features you find through research e.g. at Chichen Itza.
- Research the game Pok-A-Tok. Present your information on Google Slides then create your own 3D arena.



Music

- Can you identify and research instruments used during Ancient Mayan festivals?
- Listen to a piece of music created by a flute. Then create a mind map of how it made you feel when listening.
- Produce your own musical instrument based on the Mayan ocarinas: flutes designed in the shapes of animals. Can you use recycled materials you can find at home to create it?
