### Arts

- Look at art below, use this as inspiration to create your own coastal or ocean scene.
- Use different materials to give your art a textured feel.
- Create a model of a beach hut or a coastal town.
- Think about using materials that you may find in those areas, for example, sand, pebbles, perhaps even sea weed!



### STEM

(Science Technology Engineering Mathematics)

- Create your own model of the water cycle. Base it on a coastal scene, how many features of the coast can you include?
- Create a structure that demonstrates how rivers and the sea are involved in the water cycle.
- Do your own experiment into the different parts of the water cycle. Maybe you could film this and present your results on google slides?



### Music

- Watch and listen to some videos of the coast with the waves gently lapping on the shoreline.
- Think about how this makes you feel. Calm, relaxed, tranquil?
- Create your own piece of music that you feel reflects these feelings within you. Try to use natural resources to do this, for example, pebbles knocking together, sand rustling.
