Christians believe in the creation story set out in the Bible. Muslims believe in the creation story set out in the Qur'an and Jews believe in the creation story set out in the Torah. This story is taken from the book of Genesis and is therefore similar for these three religions.

There are lots of versions of the Hindu creation story. One is taken from the Vedas.

The major religions have different views about heaven and the afterlife. There is a shared belief that heaven is where the creator is and it is a place where worries disappear.

All the major religions say the creator made the earth, plants and animals.
