








Key Vocabulary

location	A particular place or position.
temperature	A measure of how hot or cold something or somewhere is.

Weather symbols

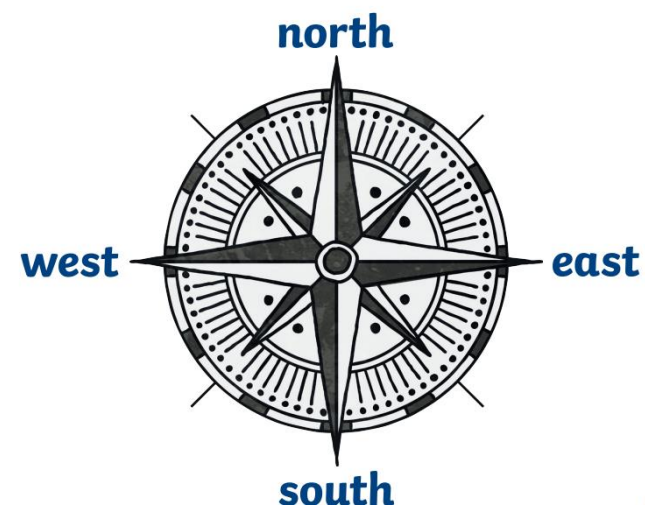
 sunny	 sunny and cloudy	 rain	 snow

The four seasons
