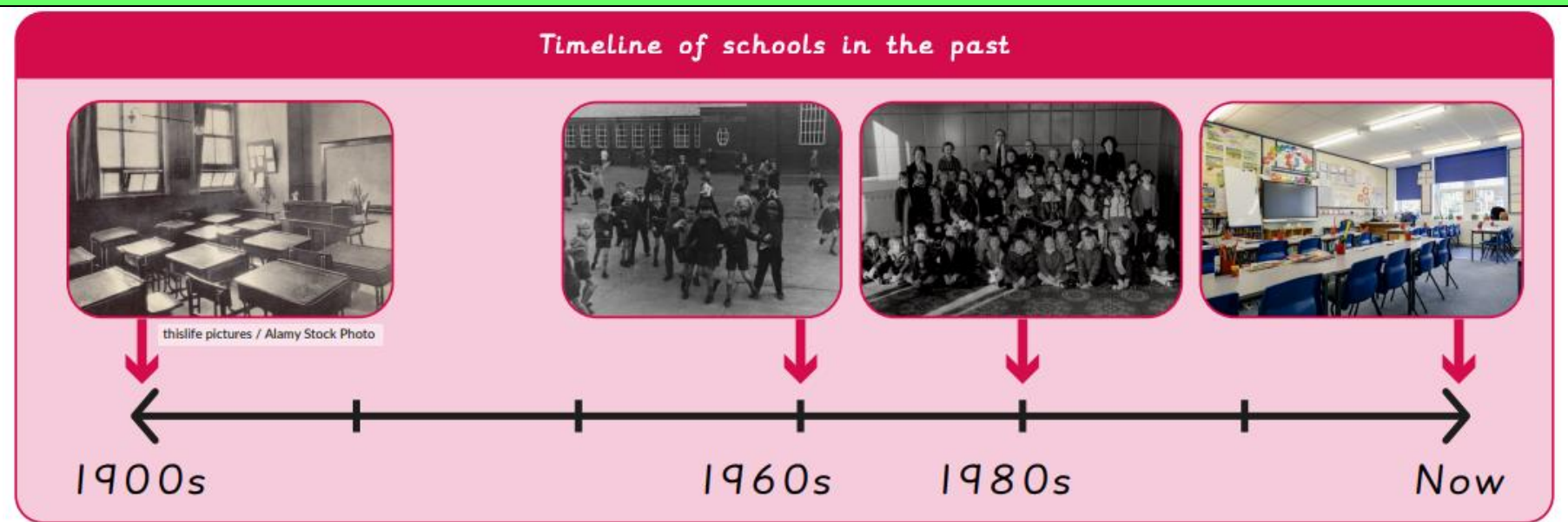


Key Vocabulary

Now

Children may finish school at 12 and get a job.  
 Children write on slates with chalk or on paper with ink.  
 Children study reading, writing, maths and religion by copying from the whiteboard.  
 Children are taught in classes of 70 pupils.

At 16 years old, some children leave school and others stay to study.  
 Children write in exercise books with pencils and pens.
