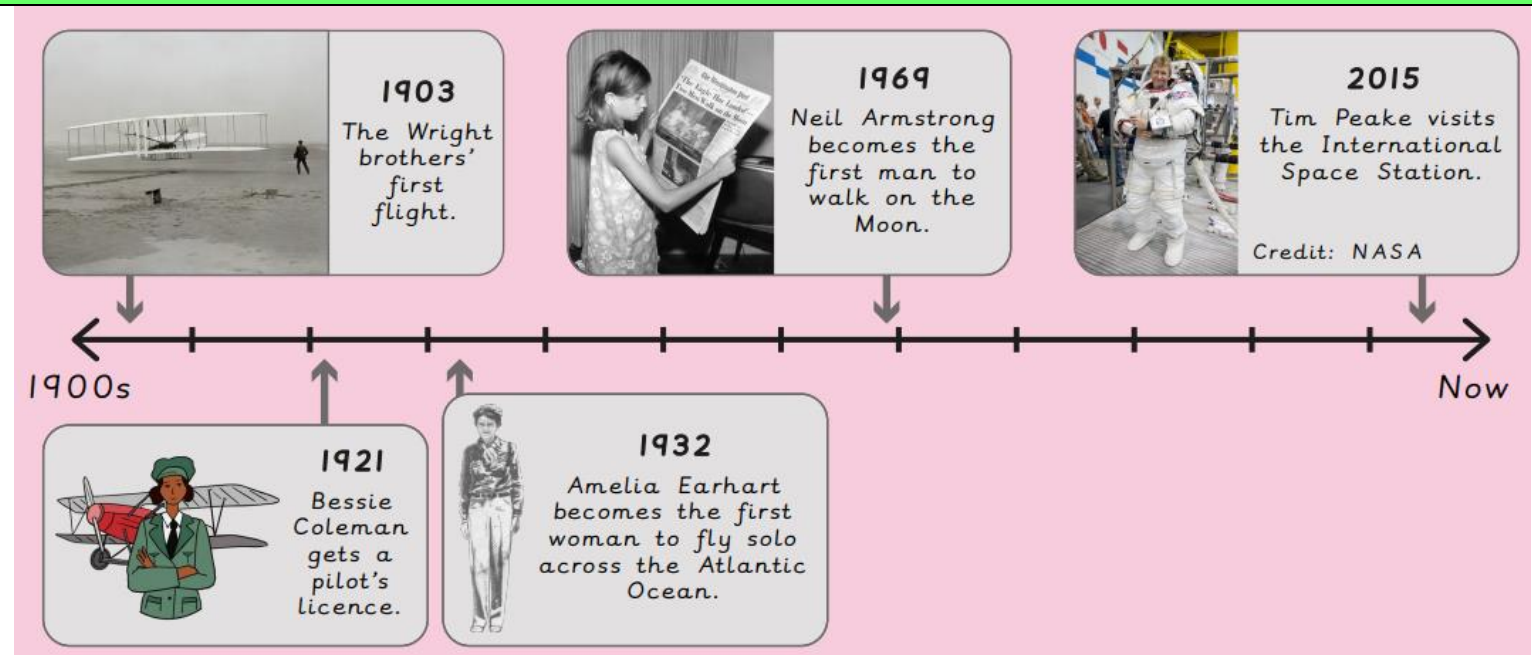






Key Vocabulary

beyond living memory	More than 100 years ago.
eyewitness account	Written record or audio recording from someone who witness an event.

  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wilbur and Orville- born in 1867 and 1871. • They began to design and build aircraft and first flew their planes in the 1900s. • In 1903 they flew the first successful engine powered aeroplane. 	  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Born in 1892. • Got her pilot's licence in 1921. • She was the first black woman to get a pilot's licence.

How has flight changed over time?



- People used hot air balloons to fly- the first one was flown in France in 1783.
- When aeroplanes were first developed, they were made out of wood.
- Aeroplanes are now made out of aluminium.
- We still have hot air balloons but they are not the main way of flying.

The Moon landing



- The first humans on the moon were Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin.
- They travelled there in the Apollo 11.
- It took 4 days.
- They took photographs and samples of the Moon rocks and dust.
- Over 10 people have been to the moon since.
