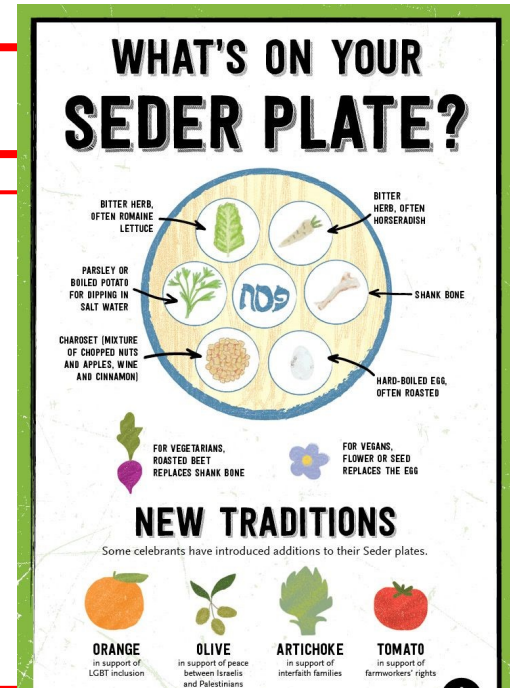
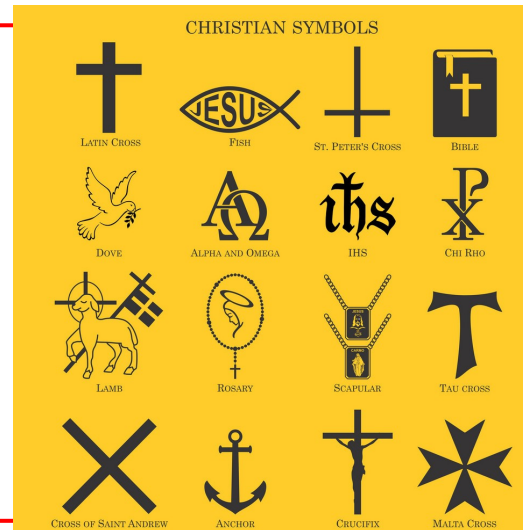


# Year 3 Subject Knowledge Organiser: RE—Signs and Symbols

## What? - Key Vocabulary

Sign	An object that represents something else.
Symbol	A thing that stands for an idea or concept.
Seder Plate	A Jewish special plate which contains symbolic foods.
Matzos	A crisp biscuit of unleavened bread, traditionally eaten by Jews at Passover.
Passover	A Jewish holiday celebrating the Hebrews' escape from slavery.
Metaphor	A figure of speech that represents something else.
Sin	An act that is considered wrong.
The Holy Trinity	Christianity's belief that God is the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit.
Worship	To love or admire a god very much.
Symbolism	Using symbols to represent ideas.
