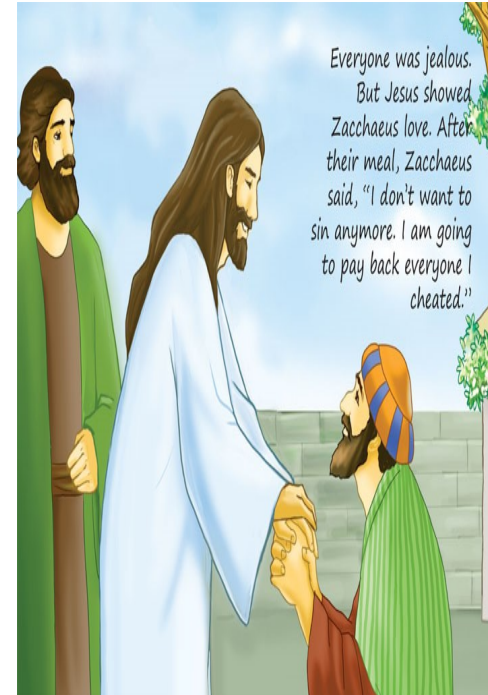


# Year 3 RE: What do we know about Jesus?

## What? - Key Vocabulary

Gospels of Mark, Matthew, Luke and John	The first four books of the New Testament in the Bible.
Miracle	An extraordinary event that cannot be explained by nature or science.
Faith	A strong belief in a religion.
Messiah	A leader of a group.
Mislead	To have a wrong idea about something.
Tax	Money that everyone has to pay has to pay to the government.

Nobody definitely knows what Jesus looked like because there are no descriptions of him in the Bible.

People who paint pictures of Jesus often paint him as looking similar to themselves—same skin colour, hair or eyes.

Artists show Jesus's personality and qualities through their artwork. He is shown as a healer, teacher, leader, miracle performer and divine being.

Jesus was disliked by many people when he was alive because he was seen as a trouble maker. He claimed to be the son of God which made religious leaders angry.

The New Testament Gospels tell us information about Jesus's personality.

The Bible uses symbolism to describe Jesus e.g 'the bread of life' and 'the light of the world'.
