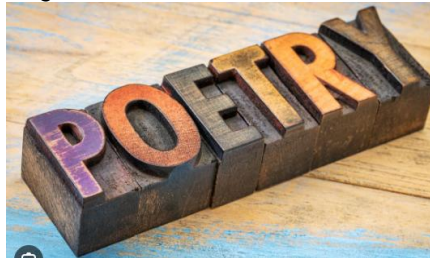
### **STEM**
