Create your own music inspired by the rainfall within the Amazon Rainforest. You could make a rain shaker to help you with this.



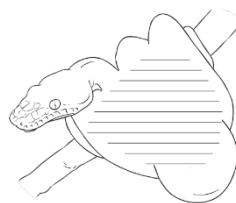
STEM
