Writing

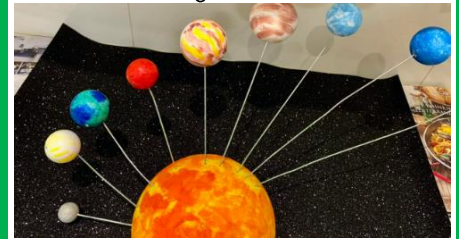
Create a persuasive poster to stop people littering our seas. You need to explain why it is so important and what impact it is having on animals and their habitats.

Maths

Can you research the decomposition times of litter that may be released into our oceans? Present it any way you wish in order to compare lengths of time.

Linked to science learning

Make a model of the solar system.



STEM

Can you research and draw the water cycle? How much detail can you research and add to it?



ROOTS

Take a photo or draw a picture of yourself following our ROOTS. This could be a photo of you helping someone around the house, taking care of a sibling or being respectful.



Art

Split a piece of paper in half. On one side draw what a polluted ocean looks like; on the other, draw what a non-polluted ocean looks like.
